LODGE RULES

GENERAL

Guests using the lodge are bound by these rules. Upon arrival, check foyer noticeboard for your room and bed allocation. Bed allocation is at the absolute discretion of the Booking Officer. *Bedrooms must be shared except where a bedroom has been exclusively booked.* Guests must sign the guest register on arrival. Bedrooms are available from 4.00 pm on day of arrival. Check out time is 11.00am.

LIABILITY OF CLUB

All persons enter the lodge at their own risk. The Club and Members thereof, accept no liability for any act, omission or breach of duty by any person which results in personal injury or damage or loss or theft of property. This includes personal items of jewellery and cash.

DOOR CODE

The main entrance to the lodge is fitted with a lock which requires a code to prevent unauthorised access. The code will be given to you on confirmation of your booking.

LODGE MANAGER

In order to safeguard the Club's property and to ensure the Lodge is run smoothly and efficiently, the Club has appointed a Manager whose directions must be adhered to.

LUGGAGE

Rooms must be vacated and all luggage and personal equipment removed by 11.00 am on the day of departure. Luggage storage by arrangement with the Manager.

STORAGE OF SKIS AND BOOTS

Ski equipment must be stored in the Ski Room.

All boots are to be removed in the entrance area and stored in the Drying Room. No outside boots are to be worn in the Lodge.

CLEANING AND DUTIES

Guests are responsible for cleaning their own bunk rooms, bathroom and the kitchen after own use. The lounge is a communal area so please leave it tidy.

FIRE SAFETY IS IMPORTANT

- (a) Interference with fire safety is prohibited.
- (b) The use of candles is prohibited.
- (c) NO SMOKING IN THE CONFINES OF THE BUILDING.
- (d) In case of fire, the Manager is the designated Fire Warden.

BEHAVIOUR

Guests are responsible for their own proper conduct. If the Manager determines that a guest's behaviour is unacceptable for any reason the Manager may refuse continued accommodation for that person without refund. The Club reserves the right to charge guests for repair of wilful damage to property or costs incurred.

Note, under Liquor Licensing Law (Victoria) it is an offence for a licensee to allow a drunken person on the premises. If a guest is drunk, violent or quarrelsome, you must leave the premises when asked, Penalty \$2,000.

DOGS

Dogs are not permitted within the Lodge or the adjacent National Park.

FACILITIES PROVIDED

Kitchen and Dining

Full kitchen (for self Catering) and dining facilities including all eating and cooking utensils, microwave ovens, fridge and freezer and dry goods storage.

Basic Condiments (tea, coffee, sugar, salt, pepper, spices, oils, jams, sauces, spreads, etc.) Bread, Milk, Butter (popular choice only), Breakfast Cereals (Weet Bix, Cornflakes, Rice Bubbles)

All Bedrooms are shared accommodation in the following formats:

All Bedrooms have Ensuite Bathrooms - Items supplied - blankets, pillows, bath mats, toilet paper, towels, sheets, pillow slips.

CHECK IN & OUT TIMES

Bedrooms are available from 4.00pm on day of arrival. Rooms must be vacated by 11.00 am on day of departure. Luggage can be stored by arrangement with the Manager.
